N°1: Early season means hungry trout...(SPINNING FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in small streams, average weight 3 to 5 pounds
 - Method used: spinning fishing
 - Fitness level required: low
 - Fishing experience required: low

N°2: Naive trout...(SPINNING FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in small streams, average weight 3 to 5 pounds
 - Method used: spinning fishing
 - Fitness level required: low
 - Fishing experience required: low

N° 3: Spontaneous trout...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in small and medium size streams, average weight 3 to 5 pounds
 - Method used: blind/sight **dry fly fishing** or blind/sight nymph fishing/Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: low
 - Fly Fishing experience required: low

N°4: End of Spring...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in streams, average weight 3 to 5 pounds, some of 6 pounds
- Methods used: blind/sight **dry fly fishing** or blind/sight nymph fishing/Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium
 - Fly Fishing experience required: medium

N°5: Summer begins means...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow/brown trout population in medium size rivers, average weight 3 to 5 pounds, up to 6 pounds
 - Methods: blind/sight **dry fly fishing** or blind/sight nymph fishing/Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium
 - Fly Fishing experience required: medium

N°6: Sight fishing starting...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow /brown trout population in medium size rivers, average weight 3 to 6 pounds
 - Methods used: mostly both sight **dry fly fishing**/nymph fishing/Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium high
 - Fly Fishing experience required: high
- Helicopter fishing/bivouacs advised

N°7: Usually the best period for sight fly fishing...(FLY FISHING)

- Brown trout average weight 3 to 5 pounds with 6 to 7 pounds possible
- Methods used: mostly both sight dry fly and nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: high
 - Fly Fishing experience required: high

N°8: Fly fish in bush...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow and brown trout populations, average weight 3 to 5 pounds
 - Methods used: mostly both sight dry fly and nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: high
 - Fly Fishing experience required: high
- Helicopter fishing (**cicada**)/bivouacs advised

N°9: Amazing streams in backwater locations...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout populations, average weight 3 to 5 pounds
 - Methods used: mostly both sight dry fly (**cicada=helicopter fishing**) and nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: high
 - Fly Fishing experience required: high
- Helicopter fishing (**cicada**)/bivouacs advised

N°10-11: end of summer...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout populations, average weight 3 to 4 pounds
 - Method used: mostly both sight dry fly (**cicada=helicopter fishing**) and nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium high
 - Fly Fishing experience required: medium
- Helicopter fishing (**cicada**)/bivouacs advised

N°12-13-14: Autumn colours delight...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in medium size rivers, average weight 3 to 4 pounds
 - Methods used: mostly both sight dry fly and nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium
 - Fly Fishing experience required: medium high
- Helicopter fishing/bivouacs advised

N°15-16: Trout feeding hard due to fresh waters and temperatures...(FLY FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in rivers
- Methods used: mostly both sight dry fly fishing/nymph fishing/ Streamer Fishing*
 - Fitness level required: medium
 - Fly Fishing experience required: low

N°17-18-19: trout feeding very hard now before spawning...(SPINNING FISHING)

- Good rainbow trout population in rivers
- Method used: spinning fishing
 - Fitness level required: low
 - Fishing experience required: low

*Streamer fishing used when rivers high, if rivers flooding, saltwater fly fishing/spinning from the shore
